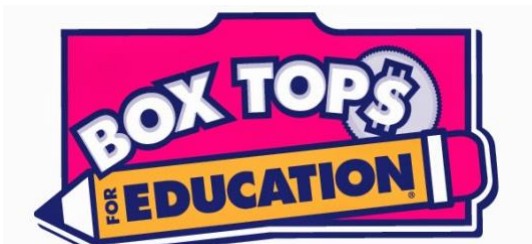


REMINDER:

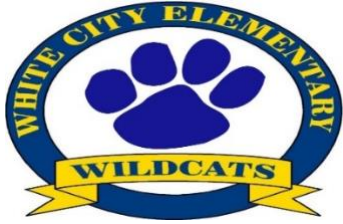
