General Information

- ▶ Please be sure to purchase school supplies for your student whether they are at school or at home. The general West Gate school supply list was posted. Teachers may send home individual class wish lists.
- ▶ Outside food, including lunches, birthday treats, will not be permitted this year.
- ▶ Each individual teacher will send home or post to TEAMS (if virtual) the information needed to join REMIND.

General Information

- We strongly suggest sending your student with **a water bottle**. Students are not allowed to drink from the fountain, but may refill water bottles with supervision and permission.
- It may be a good idea to send your student to school with **1 or 2 extra masks**. Aside from general incidents, students may find their mask gets sweaty during recess and PE.
- Your student will only get **1 copy** of consumables (Go Math books, science books, Social Studies weekly, etc.) for the year. It is extremely important they take good care of these materials and returns them to school if/when your student returns to the classroom.


