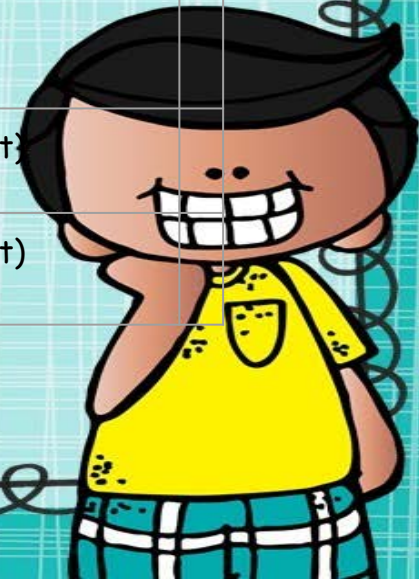

Teams



- Teams will be the platform for all live instruction.
- Teams allows for face-to-face interaction between teacher and students.
- Students will be able to ask questions in the chat window as live instruction occurs.
- Students will be able to click on a hand icon to notify teacher they have a question or want to respond.
- Please be on time for meetings with the class to prevent being marked tardy or absent.





Canvas

- Canvas will be the platform to access digital lessons.
- Canvas allows students to submit work for teachers to check for understanding and to grade.
- Students will need to click on the assigned daily button to access that day's lesson for each subject.
- If absent from school all make up work will be accessible to the student, however live instruction will be missed.



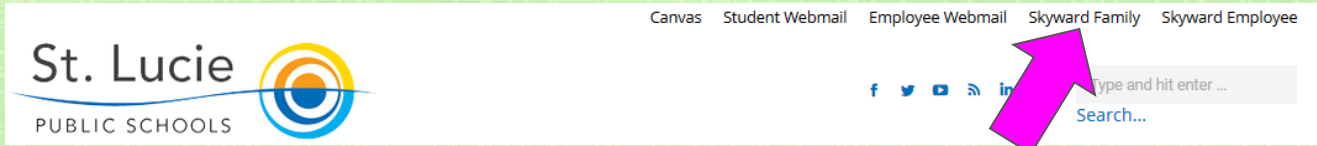
